SERVICE TO SCHOOL AWARD - CRITERIA

Students must apply for consideration for the Service to School Award.

A Service to School Application Form must be completed.

There are 2 awards: Badge for <u>leadership / organisation</u> & Certificate for <u>participation only</u>.

Criteria for Nomination:

- Students must fulfil three different major service to school categories
- All service must be school related
- In most cases the service will be voluntary and during the student's own time
- The Service Badge is for <u>leadership or organisation</u> & the Service Certificate for <u>participation</u> only
- In the case of Year 13 Leaders and other badge holders (Kāwai Huia Co-Leaders, Librarians etc.), Service to School must in an area completely different to your leadership / badge holder duties (which you already have a badge for)
- Each category of service must be a minimum of **4 hours duration**, making the total service requirement for the award <u>**12 hours**</u> minimum
- Service must come from one school calendar year only
