TECHNOLOGY BADGE - CRITERIA

For recognition of participation and commitment in Extra-Technology activities representing NPGHS (*Student contributions run from Term 1 to Term 3 each year*)

CRITERIA FOR AN TECHNOLOGY BADGE:

participation and commitment - 12 hours minimum out of class time for 3 Terms

Criteria for nomination:

- Students must fulfil **at least three different** major technology activities
- Each activity must be a minimum of **4 hours duration**, making the total activity requirement for the award 12 hours out of class time for 3 Terms
- Alternatively various activities could be completed which add to a total of **12 hours** minimum
- In most cases the service will be voluntary and during a student's own time
- All service must be **related to technology at NPGHS**
- All activities must come from **one school calendar year only**
- Activities counting toward one badge cannot count toward another badge
