TRADITIONAL ARTS BADGE - CRITERIA

Students must apply for consideration for the Traditional Arts Badge.

A Traditional Arts Badge Application Form must be completed.

Criteria for Nomination:

- Students must fulfil **at least three different** major environment activities
- Each activity must be a minimum of **4 hours duration**, making the total activity requirement for the award **12 hours** minimum
- Alternatively various activities could be completed which add to a total of **12 hours** minimum
- In most cases the service will be voluntary and during the student's own time
- All activities must come from **one school calendar year only**
- Activities counting toward one badge cannot count toward another badge
